



School Tuition Organizations

Please Apply for All Applicable Scholarship Categories

- 1) Disabled/Displaced – **This is the highest funding source for students with Autism.** Under Lexie’s Law, awards are available for students with an Arizona State approved disability(ies). These scholarships are available to students K- 12th grade who have an AZ public/charter school IEP, MET, or 504 plan. There is a prior year AZ public/charter school enrollment of at least 90 days as a requirement for students who are currently in 1st-12th grade. **If using this option for funding, Autism Academy only accepts funding based on the primary eligibility of Autism on an Arizona IEP or MET.**
- 2) Switcher/Plus – Switching from an AZ public/charter school to an AZ private school. There is a prior year AZ public/charter school enrollment of at least 90 days as a requirement for students who are currently in 1st-12th grade.
- 3) Corporate/Low Income – Family income based. There is a prior year AZ public/charter school enrollment of at least 90 days as a requirement for students who are currently in 1st-12th grade. The requirements to receive aid under low income program are based on 185% of the Free & Reduced lunch program guidelines. See the chart below for an **example** of past qualification levels:

- 4) Original/Individual – Individuals and couples receive a dollar-for-dollar credit for their Arizona tax liability. This is an Arizona State tax credit. Funding availability for the Original/Individual scholarship is based on the tax credits received by the STOs. There is no prior year enrollment requirement. K-12 students attending a qualified private school in Arizona are eligible to receive the Original/Individual scholarship.
