



Illinois State Abstinence Program Site Agreement

The Illinois State Board of Education has contracted with AMTC & Associates to provide A&M Resources abstinence education programs for Illinois schools serving grades 6-12. This document provides the terms and conditions of the program. This agreement is effective from the date signed and may be cancelled by either party with a 14-day written notice. There is no cost to the school. In order to participate in this program, schools agree to the following:

- School instructors will teach the program(s) provided by A&M Resources with fidelity. Professional development workshops will be provided and will include Illinois CPDUs.
- School instructors who have not received A&M program training within the past 10 years, will be strongly encouraged to access such training within 60 days of the site agreement signature, either through one of the live A&M professional development workshops or through A&M recorded webinars.
- School instructors will arrange for each Educator to be observed teaching one lesson per year by the Regional Coordinator or another school staff member.
- School instructors will collect and provide enrollment information and attendance sheets for the State of Illinois program verification and return attendance forms to Regional Coordinator promptly upon program implementation.
- The use of the A&M Resources program does not in any way hold A&M Resources liable for any legal claims made against the site.
- Obtain written consent from A&M Resources before publishing any statistical data pertaining to the program and/or program participants.
- Ensure that all youth will be granted equal access to the program.
- Ensure that religion will not be taught or promoted in the program.
- Ensure students understand that program is voluntary; and are provided an opportunity to opt out, according to the State of Illinois' statute 105 ILCS 5/27-9.1 150 ILCS 110/3.
- Understand that some students may be given a confidential survey to complete. Surveys are voluntary and students will be informed of their right to opt out of the survey. Surveys will be approved by administration prior to dissemination.

As a school that agrees to implement the A&M Resources program, I provide assurance that the school will provide the total hours needed for the selected program during the project period as agreed upon and we will abide by the terms and conditions stated above.
