UNC and Duke tout two of the most prominent and prestigious basketball programs in the nation. Along with two of the most prominent coaches in the history of the game. While we see the competition between these rivals at least twice a year on the court. Let's look at how the new tax bill effects both coaches' salaries.

Based on USA Today's 2017 season salaries Roy is bringing in a cool \$2,088,577 of base compensation from UNC with a max Bonus of \$1,000,000. Winning the National Championship, we'll go ahead and say he got the max portion. Bringing his total compensation to \$3,088,577.

Coach K is taking in a staggering \$5,550,475 from Duke with no max salary listed. This puts Krzyzewski 3rd in the highest paid coaches for 2017 just behind John Calipari and Rick Pitino (Before his fall from grace).
