

Drawing Music

Supplies: drawing supplies, speaker, instrumental music, paper

Activity: The idea behind this activity is to listen closely to music, be thoughtful of how it makes you feel and then interpret those feelings into art. If the music is fast you may draw jagged, sharp lines in red; if it's slow, curving, wide shapes in blue. Try many different types of music and see what you create.

Example Songs: Swan Lake by Tchaikovsky, Peter and the Wolf, by Prokofiev, Blue Bossanova by Bossanova

Scoop It Up

Supplies: spoons, ping pong balls (or small circular objects that can fit in a spoon) and bowls.

Activity: Using nothing but a spoon in your mouth, transfer six ping pong balls from one bowl to the other in less than one minute. No hands! Hands are only allowed if you drop the ping pong ball, and then they can be used to place the ball back into the original bowl for another transfer attempt.
