***What grades are eligible for each location?***

<b>Entering Grades 1 through 4</b>	May attend Winona, Mary Blair, Sarah Milner or Monroe Elementary Schools
<b>Entering Grade 5</b>	May attend either Winona, Mary Blair, Sarah Milner or Monroe <b>OR</b> our Loveland-Pulliam site
<b>Entering Grade 6 or higher</b>	Must attend our Loveland-Pulliam site

\*Please note that only Monroe and Truscott students are eligible to attend our Monroe location.

***Where do I register?***

Please visit our website [www.begreatlarimer.org](http://www.begreatlarimer.org) to register online. You must register at the site you wish to attend. If your children will attend two separate locations, two separate forms must be filled out.

***What is the cost?***

Below are our weekly rates:

**We offer financial assistance.** We understand that some families may not be in a position to afford these fees. We offer both partial and full scholarships. To apply, families need to fill out a scholarship application and submit it to their Club Director.

### ***How do payments work?***

Payments are on a monthly basis and must be prepaid by the **5th of each month**. For example, childcare in June must be paid by June 5th. Families will be able to make payments online through a parent portal using credit card or account transfer. Auto-pay can also be set up to assist with automatic withdrawals. Families that would like to make payments in person can do so by visiting their Club location during operating hours.

### ***Do you provide financial assistance?***

Yes, we have full and partial scholarships available. These scholarships can help cover either half of the monthly cost or the full amount of the monthly cost. If requested at registration parents will be sent a scholarship request form to fill out.

### ***What does a typical day look like?***

Upon arriving at Club, your child will be greeted by staff and join their group for a day of fun and enriching programs.

- Arts
  - *Craft projects, drama and theater Clubs, etc.*
- Sports, fitness & recreation
  - *Sport leagues, games tournaments, etc.*
- Health & Life Skills
  - *Cooking classes, robotics, etc.*
- Character & Leadership Development
  - *Community service projects*
- Hands-on academic enrichment
  - *STEM projects, science experiments*

### ***What extra safety precautions and checks do you have in place to prevent the spread of COVID-19?***

We are working with the Larimer County Health Department and the Thompson School District to ensure that all COVID-19 safety regulations are followed. Youth will be asked to wear a mask indoors, to practice social distancing at all times, and to wash their hands frequently. Upon arrival, youth's temperature will be taken and they will be asked a series of questions related to COVID-19 symptoms. Any youth that has a temperature above 100.4 or is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, as listed by the CDC, will be sent home. Any symptoms that arise during the day will be monitored and if those symptoms are related to COVID-19 youth will be sent home. Youth sent home with any COVID-19 symptoms must have a note from a health professional to return OR must be symptom free for 14 days before returning.

### ***Will you provide meals?***

Parents will have the option to send their child with meals, or breakfast and lunch will be provided by Thompson School District Nutrition Services at no additional charge.
