Do you serve middle and high school students?

Yes. The Boys & Girls Clubs building located at 2500 East 1st St in Loveland will be reserved for middle and high school students.

Do you offer before school programs?

Before school programs will be enrollment based and will vary from school to school. Each site will offer a before school program on late start Wednesdays from 7:00 - 9:00 a.m. Should there be sufficient student enrollment in the before school program on Mon/Tue/Thu/Fri the Club will operate the before school program on those days. To register for the before school program, make sure to select that option in your parent portal, www.myprocare.com. If you have questions about the before school program at your school, please contact your Club's Director.

What are the costs and program fees?

Program costs will vary from location to location depending on grant support. Here are the schools that are covered by 21st Century Community Learning Center grant for the 2021-2022 school year:

- Edmondson Elementary School
- Winona Elementary School
- Sarah Milner Elementary School
- Monroe Elementary School
- Truscott Elementary School
- BF Kitchen Elementary School
- Lincoln Elementary School

Here are the fees associated with the other Club Thompson locations:

Before School Only

1-5 days a week, \$185 per month (\$45/wk)

Late start, Wednesday's only, \$40 per month (\$10/wk)

After School Only

Part Time, 1-3 days a week, \$175 per month (\$40/wk)

Full Time, 4-5 days a week, \$300 per month (\$70/wk)

Before & After School

Part Time, 1-3 days a week, \$360 per month (\$85/wk)

Full Time, 4-5 days a week, \$480 per month (\$115/wk)



School Out Day

\$20/day additional fees

**** BGCLC fees will only incur up to \$1200 per month, per family. No family will ever pay over \$1200 per month. We also have scholarships available. See below for more information on scholarships.***

Are there financial assistance options?

We recognize that these fees can be burdensome to families, therefore we will have limited full and partial scholarships available. To access a scholarship that can cover either the partial or full cost of monthly fees, please fill out the scholarship application form the welcome packet and give it to your Club Director. You can also request a scholarship application from your Club's Director. Scholarship requests will be processed within two business days. .

How do payments work?

Invoices are emailed monthly and must be prepaid by the **5th of each month**. For example, your monthly payment for childcare in September must be paid by September 5th. Parents will be able to make payments online through a parent portal using a credit card or through an account fund transfer. Auto-payments can also be set up to assist with automatic withdrawals. Parents that would like to make payments in person can do so by visiting their Club location during operating hours. Parents wishing to join the Club in the middle of the month or billing cycle can receive a prorated amount.

Will you provide meals?

Parents will have the option to send their child with meals, or breakfast and lunch will be provided by TSD Nutritional Services, during school-out days. Youth will also be given a snack once everyday.
