What are the costs and program fees?

There is a \$20 per year membership fee for each child enrolled in the school year program. If you would like to request a scholarship to cover this fee, please speak with your Club Director.

*There is no program fee for Eagles Club at Wellington Middle School.

How do payments work?

All membership fees must be paid before your child(ren) can attend the program. Payments can be made through the parent portal at www.myprocare.com or in person at your local Club.

Do you provide financial assistance?

Yes, we have scholarships available. If you would like to request a scholarship application, please contact your Club's Director.

Is transportation provided?

We are currently working with local school districts to develop routes from schools to Boys & Girls Clubs. If transportation is provided from your school to the Boys & Girls Club, you will be contacted as soon as possible with additional information about signing up for transportation services.

Will you provide meals?

Afternoon snacks are provided at all Club locations. Dinner is provided at the Fort Collins Club (located next to Lincoln Middle School) and Loveland-Pulliam Club locations only. All meals are provided by the Food Bank for Larimer County. Parents also have the option to send their child with their own snacks or meals.
