- 4. Customer reserves the right to sell goods at the price he sees fit.
- Consignor agrees to give the customer a minimum of one month from the day he receives the goods to sell the goods.
- 6. Customer agrees that 50% of the profit from the sale of these goods will be mailed to the Consignor via cashier's check within 48 hours of the sale, along with a detailed profit and loss statement for the goods.
- 7. If goods are not sold within one month of the receiving of the goods, then the consignor will have the option to reclaim their goods, receive 50% of the potential profit based on
