

Ben's Repurposed Cabinetry Consignment Contract

This agreement is being made between _____(consignor) and

1. Consignor has turned over the goods described below, which shall remain property of the Consignor until such time as they are sold.

2. Customer operates a used cabinetry store and agrees to make his best effort to sell the Consignor's goods.
3. Customer reserves the right to repair and clean the goods as he sees fit. Such costs will be subtracted from the profit.
4. Customer reserves the right to sell goods at the price he sees fit.
5. Consignor agrees to give the customer a minimum of one month from the day he receives the goods to sell the goods.
6. Customer agrees that 50% of the profit from the sale of these goods will be mailed to the Consignor via cashier's check within 48 hours of the sale, along with a detailed profit and loss statement for the goods.
7. If goods are not sold within one month of the receiving of the goods, then the consignor will have the option to reclaim their goods, receive 50% of the potential profit based on

the _____(date) asking price (in which case the customer will receive ownership of the goods), or continue to wait for the goods to be sold.
