#### PART 1 - GENERAL

## 1.01 DESCRIPTION

A. Particle board/ plastic laminate work includes the following:

#### 1. Recessed medicine Cabinet

B. Furnish all labour and materials necessary for the completion of work in this section as shown on the contract drawings and specified herein.

C. Work in this section shall include, but is not limited to:

- 1. Medicine cabinets
- 2. Hardware for medicine cabinets
- 3. Shop drawings and working drawings
- 4. Manufacturer's guarantee

#### 1.02 PRODUCT

Submit two (2) sets of shop drawings and details for architect's approval.

Colours and textures of the units are determined by the selected decorative pattern. Not all colours have the same lead time. Check with Bow Wood distributor for lead times.

Colour samples and hardware samples shall be submitted for approval by the architect upon request.

#### PART 2 – PRODUCTS

#### 2.01 MANUFACTURER

Medicine Cabinets to be supplied by Bow Wood Cabinet Systems, Saskatchewan, (888) 269 9663 or approved equal.

#### 2.02 MATERIALS

Cabinets shall be 5/8" (16) overall thickness, constructed of %" particle board and each face to have a decorative finish, thermofused with pressure.

Doors shall be 3/4" (19) overall thickness, constructed of particle board and one layer on each face of 1/32" decorative plastic laminate sheets, fused with pressure; or as alternate finishes included in range options specified by Bow Wood Cabinet Systems.

The colour and texture of the finish on the cabinet system is determined by the selected decorative pattern of the plastic laminate or MCP finish.

#### **PART 3 – EXECUTION**

#### 3.01 PREPARATION

Examine locations to receive cabinet system for correct height and spacing of anchorage/blocking and plumbing fixtures that may affect installation and/or door swing. Report any discrepancies to the architect. Ensure correct blocking is provided.

Take complete and accurate measurements of cabinet system locations.

Start of work constitutes acceptance of job.

#### 3.02 INSTALLATION

Install cabinets straight, plumb, and level, as shown on shop drawings and manufacturer's installation instructions.

Clearance at vertical edges of doors shall be uniform top to bottom.

Finished surfaces shall be cleaned after installation and be left free of all imperfections.

### 3.03 WARRANTY

Bow Wood Cabinet Systems guarantees its MU1200 medicine cabinet systems, properly maintained, against discolouration or delamination for 2 years from the date of receipt by the customer. If materials are found defective during that period for the reasons listed above, the materials will be replaced free of charge. No credit or allowances will be issued for any labour or expenses relating to the replacement of components covered under the warranty plan. All such expenses are to be borne by the buyer.
