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

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
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Site Map on Satellite Imagery - 1.6 Miles Wide

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
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Site Map on Satellite Imagery - 0.8 Miles Wide

Currently, 53.6% of the 2,958 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8%, renter occupied; and 13.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 2,834 housing units in the area - 58.7% owner occupied, 28.1% renter occupied, and 13.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.92%. Median home value in the area is \$102,500, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 7.70% annually to \$148,500.

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
