

Why should you recycle glass at FoCo Cafe?

In Colorado, only 17% of glass actually gets recycled. The rest ends up in landfills and glass contaminates 25% of the other recycled materials it's combined with. Remove glass from your single-stream bin and ensure that it gets recycled by bringing it to FoCo Cafe or another glass recycling site in Fort Collins.


