

Fort Collins Figure Skating Club – FCFSC 2016-2017 Financial Distribution Policy and Application

Funding for the Fort Collins Figure Skating Club Financial Distribution comes from the collective efforts of all members during fundraising activities. For the past year these have included Spring Spectacular tables, FCFSC Competitions, sales of retail items at various events. The amount of available money varies from year to year.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL DISTRIBUTION:

1. Skater must be a current Full Home Club member of the Fort Collins Figure Skating Club (formerly the Ice Skating Club of Fort Collins) and have been a member for the previous full membership year July 1, 2015– June 30, 2016. The one-year commitment does not apply to Level A.
2. The skater and the skater's senior member have renewed membership for the current membership year July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017, and that membership has not lapsed.
3. The skater is a "member in good standing" because the skater or someone on behalf of the skater has contributed to the club by volunteering at competitions or other club activities, and owes no money to the club.
4. This form is complete, accurate, and legible and signed by the skater or (if under 18) a parent.
5. Valid receipts from the said competition or event have been stapled to this request and submitted **after** the event has been attended. Valid receipts include coaching fees, hotel & travel expenses, and entry fees. Skaters may be asked to provide proof of participating in the event.
6. Volunteer hours: The skater, or someone representing this skater, has volunteered at competitions or events for the Fort Collins Figure Skating Club. A completed copy of the attached FCFSC Volunteer Log form must be submitted with this application. All required volunteer hours must be completed before a check will be issued. 7. Applications must be submitted no later than July 31, 2017, with all expenses incurred by June 30, 2017.
8. Reimbursements may not exceed limits per level. Reimbursement amounts must be accompanied by matching receipts, and skaters may only claim the actual amount spent.
9. These reimbursements reward skaters for actively participating in programs, events, or competitions on behalf of FCFSC. Therefore, general coaching fees, contract ice, and equipment purchases affiliated with practice are not reimbursable.

Levels of Funding for 2016-2017

Participation required for ALL events requesting reimbursement

Amounts are variable each membership year depending on event criteria, location and available funds.

****ONE AWARD PER LEVEL, PER MEMBERSHIP YEAR**

LEVEL A: \$100

Fees associated with non-qualifying events/competitions (including Adult Sectionals), in-house skating education seminars and workshops, test sessions, and Theatre on Ice registration during the current year. Examples of approved fees include hotel stays at competitions, coaching fees at competition/tests and practice ice fees at competition/tests. **Private lessons and skate equipment do not apply. Only 1 distribution at this level is allowed per year per skater and for each syncro team as applicable.

List competitions or events with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$100:

LEVEL A2: \$200

Skaters that participated in at least 4 non-qualifying competitions may opt to claim Level A2 INSTEAD of Level A. This level EXCLUDES the SW Nine States Championships, National Solo Dance, National Showcase and any other competitions that have a separate level of Financial Distribution listed in Level B. **Skaters that Claim Level A2 may not claim Level A.

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$200:

LEVEL B: In state: \$200; Out of State: \$350

First Level Qualifying Events at Midwestern (Pairs & Dance); Non-Qualifying Adult Nationals, Qualifying Adult Sectionals and Collegiate Nationals.

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$200 (in state) or \$350 (out of state):

LEVEL B2: In state: \$200; Out of State: \$350

SW Regionals First Level Qualifying Events (Juv and above), 9 States Non-Qualifying (Juv and above), SW Regionals Non-Qualifying Events (Beginner through Senior, Well Balanced Free Skate, Test Track, Compulsories, Pre-Juvenile Pairs/Dance). ** This level excludes Learn-To-Skate

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$200 (in state) or \$350 (out of state):

LEVEL C: \$500

Second Level Qualifying Events at Adult Nationals, Midwestern Sectionals (Singles) and US Nationals (Pairs and Dance)

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$500:

LEVEL D: \$500

Third Level Qualifying Events at US Nationals (Singles)

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$500:

LEVEL E: In state: \$200; Out of State: \$350

National Showcase: (Singles and Duets)

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$200 (in state) or \$350 (out of state):

LEVEL F: \$25 for Individual Member

National Showcase (Theatre Ensembles)

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$25:

LEVEL G: \$50 for Individual Team Member

Synchro Midwest & Pacific Coast Sectionals

List competitions with matching receipts totalling a minimum of \$50:

LEVEL H: \$50 for Individual Team Member
