

## BANQUET AWARD NOMINATIONS

The FCFSC Annual Banquet will take place on Saturday, March 4, 2017 at the Ptarmigan Country Club. Last year, we changed the nomination/voting process, giving you the opportunity to nominate **AND** vote for the winners. We will do the same this year.

Nominations are due by **January 23, 2017**. As coaches, you are the only people that can nominate skaters for these awards, so please take the time to do so, as these awards mean a lot to our skaters.

### You may submit nominees one of 3 ways:

3. Place a hard copy of this form (a nomination form is on the back of this document) OR your own typed nominations in the locked file cabinet in the green rink (next to the coaches room door).

### What you need to do:

1. Review the award descriptions below and come up with one nominee for EACH of the two awards. These skaters do not have to be your students.
2. For each award, come up with 2-3 reasons why this skater is deserving of the given award and write them out as bullet points, sentences, or as an essay. All forms are acceptable.
3. Submit your nominations to me one of the two ways listed above. If you prefer to hand-write your nominations, you may do so on the back of this page, as it is a nomination form. Then, just drop this form in the locked cabinet.

### Awards:

1. **Leadership Award:** "True leaders have a can-do attitude; they are active, not passive; leaders work with others to bring ideas to life; leaders create or facilitate a vision of what is to be done and how it can be accomplished; leaders take on challenges; leaders are role models and inspire others to be their personal best."
2. **Perseverance Award:** "Sticking to a goal and never giving up on what one has to do; being determined to improve; being committed; not leaving things unfinished; striving for excellence. Steady persistence in adhering to a course of action, a belief, or a purpose."
