SIGN UP OPTIONS:

- LTS (non tested skaters of all levels)- May sign up for one event- "NOT TESTED LEARN TO SKATE REGISTRATIONS"
- Pre-preliminary freeskate tested and Adult Pre-Bronze-Silver freeskate may sign up for 1 event: "TESTED SKATER REGISTRATION"
- Preliminary through Senior and Adult Gold may sign up for 2 events: "TESTED SKATER REGISTRATION" AND "TESTED SKATER REGISTRATION SECOND EVENT"

Signing up for these events includes all rehearsal, ice and coaching costs. Costumes are an additional fee. NOTE TO ALL SKATERS! We will prioritize scheduling rehearsal time for these events. If you choose to sign up for "additional sign up options" we CANNOT GUARANTEE that there won't be overlapping rehearsal schedules. We will do our best, but we cannot guarantee it. Please remember this when you are signing up for additional options!

ADDITIONAL SIGN UP OPTIONS:

- High School seniors may sign up for an additional event: "HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR SOLO"
- Basic 4-Pre-preliminary tested skaters may sign up the team event: "TEAM REGISTRATION-INTRO TO SHOWCASE"
- Pre-preliminary-Senior freeskate tested skaters may sign up for "TEAM REGISTRATION-THEATER ON ICE"
- Adult and youth synchro teams will sign up as INDIVIDUALS in "TEAM REGISTRATION-SYNCHRONIZED SKATING"
- Members of EPIC Production Showcase team will sign up as INDIVIDUALS in "TEAM REGISTRATION-EPIC PRODUCTIONS" (Do not sign up for this if you have not already committed to the team"
- Special Olympics event: "SPECIAL OLYMPICS REGISTRATION"
- Pairs Teams will register under "PAIRS REGISTRATION"

For each of these events, registration costs only cover the ice time for tech week, dress rehearsal and the shows. Rehearsal fees including coaching and ice will be an additional cost.

High School Seniors:

All high school senior skaters are invited to sign up to perform a solo at the Spring Show. They will coordinate music choices with the show coaches and may hire a coach to choreograph their number or they may do it on their own. Costumes will need to be purchased on their own with approval from the ice show coaches.

Synchronized Skating Teams:

Adult and youth synchro teams are managed by Coaches Pam Kurtz (pkurtz2006@hotmail.com) and Denaysa Sisemore (loudensis@hotmail.com). Please contact them for information about rehearsal costs and times.

Intro to Showcase:

There is a city class through the recreator over the week of Spring Break in March that will help introduce younger skaters to the concept of “show skating”. Enrollment in this class is not mandatory to participate in the Ice show’s “Intro to Showcase” number but it will be the same program. Skaters must be basic 4 through pre-preliminary and willing to pay for additional rehearsals TBD in April and May including tech week rehearsals. This group will be managed by TBD. Theater on Ice:

Theater on ice will be a new production number incorporation the concepts of theater on ice skating. Theatre On Ice (TOI) is a form of competitive figure skating that combines the grace of figure skating with the excitement of theatre and dance. Known as “Ballet on Ice” in Europe, TOI teams consist of eight to 24 skaters on the ice telling a story together. This group will be open to all skaters 18 and under who have passed at least the pre-preliminary freeski test. Rehearsals, ice and coach fees will be arranged for separately and will be an additional charge. The Theater on ice team is managed by coach Ali (sturtevant.ali@gmail.com).

EPIC Productions:

EPIC Productions is a competitive Showcase team. Casting for this group takes place in December each year and commitments are made in January. The cost to join this team is separate from the show and involves travel commitments. Casting is open to skaters Preliminary and above. Special Olympics:

Registration is open to all special Olympics skaters. They may have up to 2 helpers at no additional cost. Coaching and rehearsal time is not covered with registration fees. Costumes must be approved by ice show coaches.

Pairs/Dance teams:

Registration is open to all pairs and dance teams. Coaching and rehearsal time is not covered with registration fees. Costumes must be approved by ice show coaches.

LTS Helpers:

Open to tested Pre-preliminary skaters and above (18yo and younger) must be available to help at all LTS rehearsal times (T/R 4:45-6:15) and must agree to buy an additional costume if necessary.

COSTUMES:

There is a \$60 non-refundable costume fee that will be collected separately after registration through EntryEeze. We will do our best to keep costume costs to \$60 but they may be higher and we will invoice the difference by email.

LEVELS:

Levels are based on freeskate or dance level ([as per 2022-2023 National Showcase rules](#)) whichever is higher as of February 19, 2023. If you have questions, ask your coach or email
