<u>Course Description</u>: This course is designed to equip the student with specific crash avoidance skills. The maneuvers performed will subject the vehicle described below to sudden and abrupt turns, and hard braking to include activation of the ABS system (if equipped) or front wheel lockup and release (threshold braking) if not equipped with ABS.

<u>Inspection Purpose</u>: This inspection is solely to evaluate the general condition of the vehicle as it relates to its use in the course described above. The inspection is intended to discover any discoverable repairs or replacements required to render the described vehicle safe for use in the course.
