

DESCRIPTION OF MATERIAL		<p>HUMAN, CANINE, FELINE, EQUINE, AND PORCINE BLOOD/ BLOOD PRODUCTS, OTHER BODY FLUIDS, AND TISSUES THAT MAY CONTAIN BARTONELLA SPECIES, BORRELLIA SPECIES, EHRlichia SPECIES, ANAPLASMA SPECIES, MYCOPLASMA SPECIES, AND RICKETTSIA SPECIES. AN ADDITIONAL CONDITION OF ISSUANCE FOR THIS PERMIT IS THAT APHIS OR CDC MUST BE NOTIFIED (IMMEDIATELY FOR A TIER 1 SELECT AGENT AND WITHIN 7 DAYS FOR A NON-TIER 1 SELECT AGENT) BY THE PERMITTEE OF THE IDENTIFICATION OF A SELECT AGENT OR TOXIN IN MATERIAL SUBJECT TO THIS PERMIT. The possession of a permit issued by the CDC does not satisfy permitting requirements placed on materials by the U. S. Department of Agriculture that may pose hazards to agriculture or agricultural production in addition to hazards to human health.
