

Youth Sunday
(Expectations and Goals)

A. To be a participant in the choir or “extras” in the youth service:

1. All youth will be permitted and encouraged to sing and participate in the youth service.
2. The Youth Minister will assign roles and responsibilities.

B. To be a performer in the youth service:

1. A performer will take a greater role in the worship service.
 - a. Read scripture, preside at the Table, sing a solo, perform a skit, etc.
 - b. Usually requires extra rehearsals and time commitment.
2. The privilege of being a performer is reserved for those who are actively participating in the youth program at Hillside Christian Church.
 - a. Active participation is defined as attending at least two youth events each month.
 - b. “Youth events” are considered Youth Group Meetings on Sunday afternoon, Youth Group Meetings on Wednesday evening, Sunday Morning Church School, Special Midweek Youth Meetings, Fund Raising Events and Youth Trips.
 - c. While not required, the goal should be at least half (50%) of all youth activities.
3. The Youth Minister will assign roles and responsibilities.

C. To be the/a speaker or guest preacher in the youth service:

1. The privilege of being a speaker is reserved for high school seniors who anticipate graduating.
2. The privilege of being a speaker is reserved for those who are actively participating in the youth program at Hillside Christian Church.
 - a. Active participation is defined as attending at least two youth events each month.
 - b. “Youth events” are considered Youth Group Meetings on Sunday afternoon, Youth Group Meetings on Wednesday evening, Sunday Morning Church School, Special Midweek Youth Meetings, Fund Raising Events and Youth Trips.
 - c. While not required, the goal should be at least half (50%) of all youth activities.
3. Adult Sponsors must see in each youth a strong spiritual maturity,

1 scriptural knowledge and Christian character.

2 4. The selected speaker(s) must be with the Youth Minister at least
3 twice in preparation for Youth Sunday, to clarify scripture, theme,
4 and review and approve the message to be presented.

5 5. The Youth Minister will make the selection of the speaker(s) for
6 youth Sunday.

7 a. If there is no suitable student for youth Sunday, the Youth
8 Minister will use his/her discretion for the morning
9 message.
