

Larimer County COVID-19 Isolation/Recovery/Quarantine Site for People Experiencing Homelessness

The site is organized by the Health District of Northern Larimer County and staffed by both the Health District and Homeward Alliance, we offer a voluntary site for people experiencing homelessness in Larimer County with prioritization of the following:

1. **a positive COVID-19 test and still in the recommended isolation period, OR**
2. **symptoms consistent with COVID-19 until testing can be completed or asymptomatic and safe to return to the community, OR**
3. **a recent exposure to someone with COVID-19 and needing to quarantine**

If you have an individual in Larimer County that does not fit the above criteria but you feel that this site is the safest option for them, please contact us directly and a decision will be made on a case by case basis for accepting them.

Referral Process

If you have identified someone who is experiencing homelessness in Larimer County and meets the criteria above, call the number below to begin the referral process and arrange for transportation **between the hours of 8am-6pm**. If after 6pm, other arrangements will need to be made until site staff can be contacted the next morning to arrange for transportation and placement.

Guests will remain at the site until safe to return to the community based on CDC and local public health guidance. If a guest chooses to leave against staff guidance, local public health officials and the referring party will be notified.

What services are we providing?

- **Transportation** - will be arranged by Health District/Homeward Alliance site staff (if needed) and the individual will be picked up at their current location (within Larimer County) and transported to our site.
- **Meals** - 3 meals/day will be provided to all guests on site
- **Staffing** - when guests are present, the site will have either staff or security on-site 24/7
- **Health Monitoring/Case Mgmt** - staff will provide ongoing health/symptom monitoring and basic case mgmt/care coordination services for guests while at our site. **No medical care is provided at this site**, nor does this site pay for medical care for guests. However, staff will monitor guests and make connections to medical care when possible

Upon arrival to the site, guests will be greeted by a staff member who will help them with intake, room assignment, and supply them with essential items including: change of clothes, toiletries, snacks, and meals
