



GKN Chemtronics Hires Hutchison Group to Negotiate New Labor Agreements for Boeing Acquisition in Kent WA

New Agreement Improves Productivity and Competitiveness

January 2002 - GKN PLC has acquired, through its Chemtronics Division, the Thermal Joining Center (TJC) in Kent, Washington State, from the Boeing Company Military Aircraft and Missiles Group.

This increases its presence on the F22 Raptor fighter aircraft program and raising the value of the program to GKN to 1.4 billion dollars. The facility produces an important titanium assembly for the F22 using electron beam welding, it said. The US Air Force is currently set to acquire 331 F22 Raptors through 2013





Prior to concluding the Transaction, GKN Chemtronics hired Hutchison Group to negotiate new labor agreements related to its Acquisition of Boeing's Thermal Joining Center operation.
