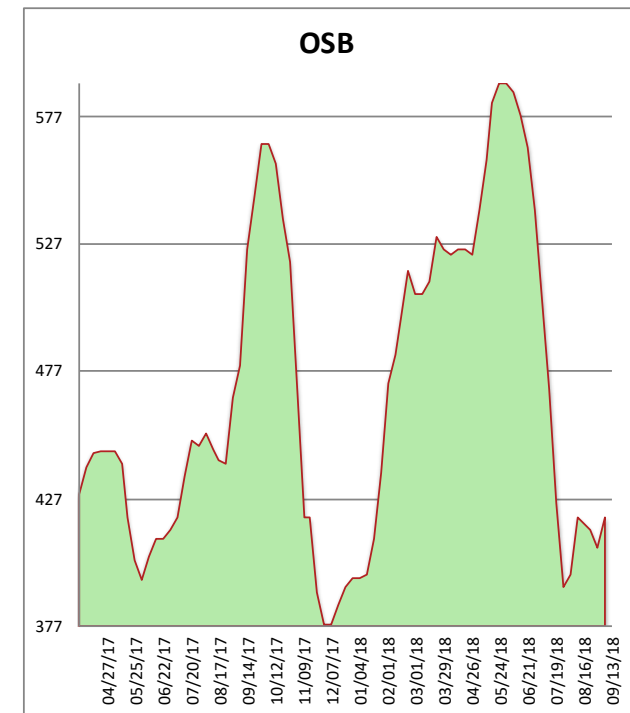
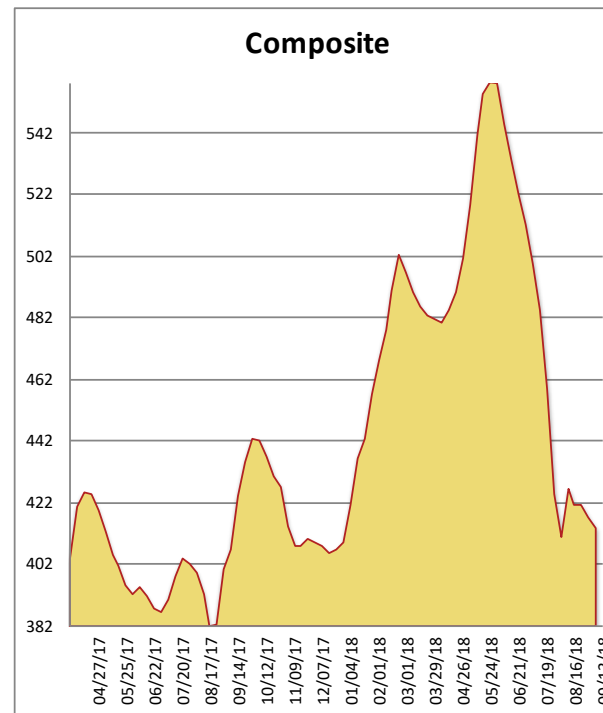

Lumber prices softened in most species and regions this week on mediocre demand. Counters at both the mill and the secondary level were readily available. All eyes are on the Carolina coast as Hurricane Florence slowly churned closer. Anticipated wide-spread power outages are expected as a tremendous amount of water is expected to inundate the area over several days. Panel markets in that region saw supply tighten in anticipation of the storm. The reality is that this storm will cause substantial disruptions to jobsites and to manufacturers in the mid-Atlantic region, slowing both supply and demand.
