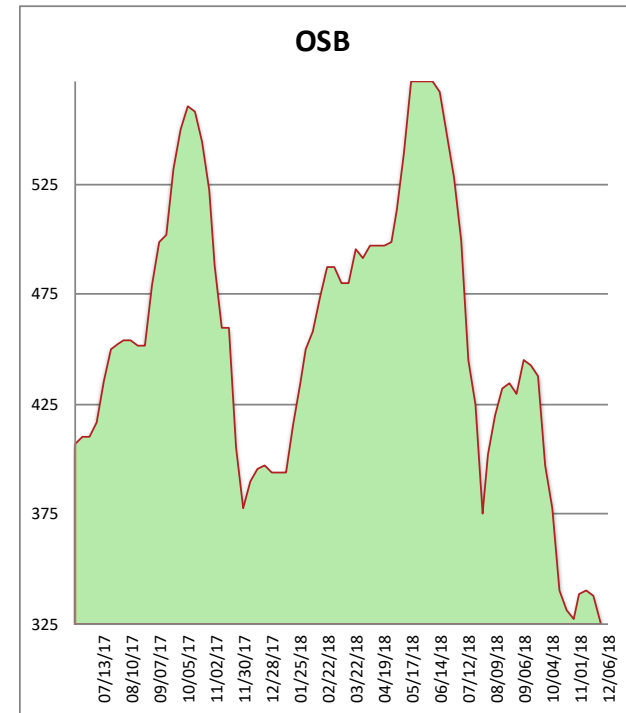
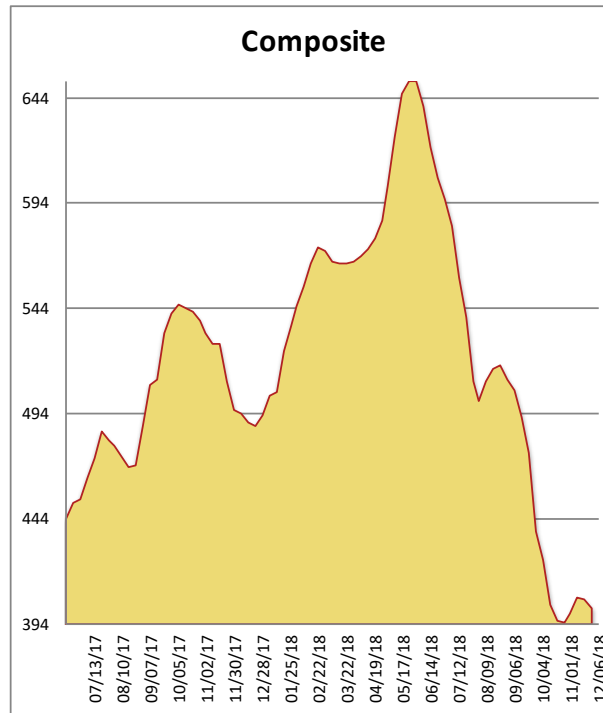

Winter weather across much of the country impacted takeaway of commodity wood products this week. Brokers and distributors working to sell off contracts and lean up their inventories for year end struggled to find takers. OSB in particular seemed to be a tough sell. In dimension lumber, narrows were readily available in most species, but wide dimension was more difficult to source. With the sense that many buyers would kick into holiday mode soon, traders eyed the next ten days to get business tied up before the tent stakes are pulled and the circus that was 2018 is finished.
