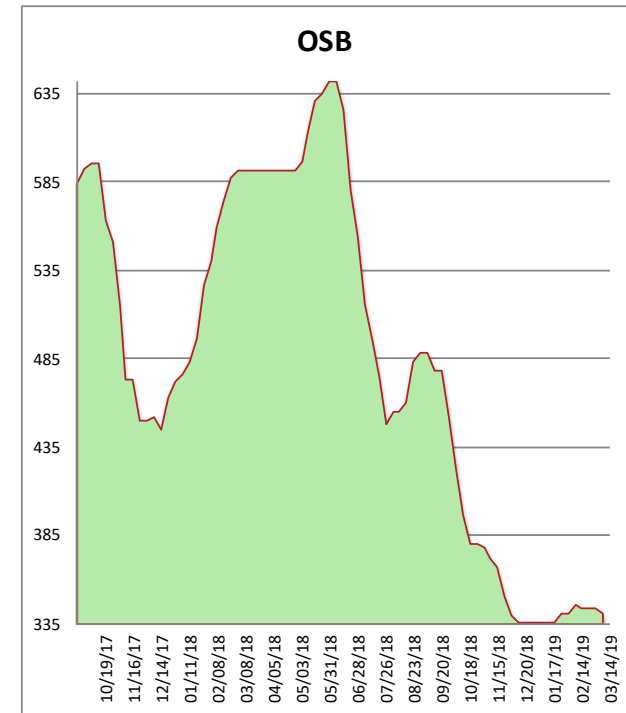
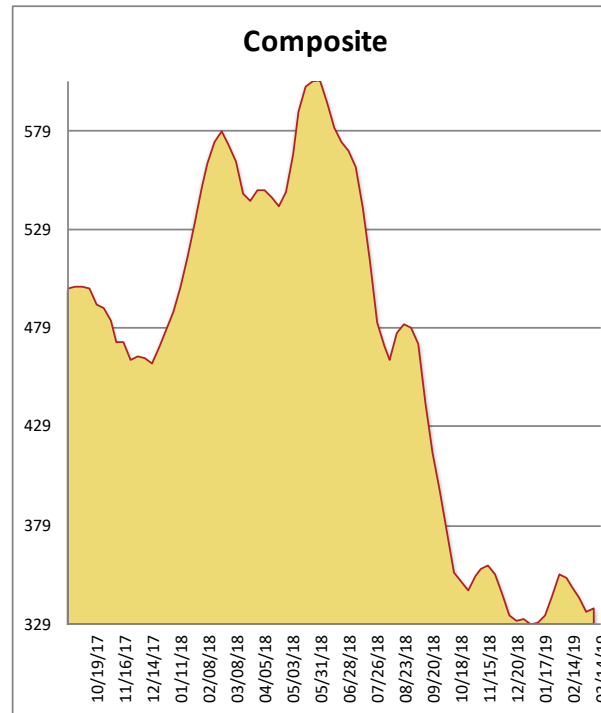

OSB sales pace continued to lag across most regions as winter weather continued to subdue demand. Most producers held quotes similar to previous weeks and most buyers believe there is little to no downside risk in the short term. Inland lumber mills also experienced another blast of winter storms causing more shutdowns and leaving another 6-8 inches of snow in some regions. Overall lumber prices remained the same as last week levels but most believed pent up demand was growing. Forecasts are showing warmer spring weather starting early next week.
