IDS International has been awarded a seat on USAID's Building Resilient and Inclusive Communities in Conflict (BRICC) program for activities within North East Syria.

USAID's objective with BRICC is to foster resilience and stability in conflict-affected communities across Syria. Program goals include preventing the re-emergence of extremists groups; counter the influence of malign actors; empower communities to negotiate a peaceful resolution to conflict; and pave the way for safe, dignified, and voluntary return of internally displaced persons and refugees.

This five-year indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contract will have task orders awarded for a variety of results-focused projects. Activities and objectives are centered around ensuring essential services are restored and accessible; inclusive, participatory, accountable, and transparent governance strengthened. This includes ensuring livelihoods are restored and economies are revived; access to education and vocational training is expanded; and access to healthcare, mental health, and psycho-social support services are increased.

BRICC is an extension of the mission critical work IDS has been performing in conflict ridden communities, globally. IDS's work on programs such as USAID's Monitoring Support Project and INL's Flexible Implementation Assessment Team required the same expertise in applying an integrated, multi-sectoral, conflict-sensitive approach with all stakeholders.
