Basic FAQ

What are your hours? We are open Monday – Friday from 7:00am – 6:00 pm

What schedules do you offer? We offer 3 different daily schedules. Children may attend 2-5 days a week. You may choose the day your child attends, it does need to be on a set schedule.

✓ Morning Program: 9:00-12:30
 ✓ Full School Day: 9:00-3:00
 ✓ Extended Day: 7:00-6:00

School Closings: We are closed for major holidays and two staff training days. A complete calendar is in the school handbook.

Are you licensed or affiliated? We are licensed by the NJ Department of Children and Families. We have annual inspections as well as surprise inspections all year long. We are affiliated with NAEYC and follow their guidelines for developmentally appropriate practices.

Are your staff members educated and trained? Our staff members and teachers are all educated and experienced in early childhood education and development. Many hold college degrees and / or CDAs. Monthly training is conducted across a broad range of topics for all staff members. All of our lead teachers have a minimum of 2 years' experience, most have over 15 years!!



How is your staff turnover? We have VERY LOW STAFF

TURNOVER. This is important because your children and families need to form close bond with their caregivers and teachers.

Ratios / Class Size: We maintain class sizes and ratios at or below the state of New Jersey rules.

- > 0 18 months (1:4)
- > 18 months 2 1/2 years (1:6)
- \geq 2 1/2 4 years (1:10)
- > 4 years (1:12)
- > 5 years and older (1:15)

Are children of different ages grouped together? Children are grouped into their classes based upon their age and developmental level. Children of various ages do come together for special events, parties, trips and opening and closing periods. This allows the academic growth for each child with similarly skilled children but also the occasional mixed age grouping leads to our family feel we strive to have in our program.

Do you welcome parent involvement, can I stop by unannounced? The answer is "YES!" Our school is a community that is open and encourages family participation. We host events throughout the year, including parties, trips, special guest visitors and more!

How do you communicate with parents? We have classroom bulletin boards, "My Day" notes, a monthly newsletter, emails and weekly postings on Facebook and Pinterest. We also conduct children's progress reports twice a year and offer parent teacher conferences in the fall and spring.

What will my child be learning in your preschool? We offer an academic, literature based curriculum. All classes have sequential and developmentally learning opportunities daily. We also have month long community service projects, holiday celebrations, and multicultural activities throughout the year.

Do you prepare for school readiness? Our programs are designed to assure that your child will be ready for Kindergarten. We have collaborated with local school districts to assure that our students are prepared beyond the standards currently established for kindergarten readiness. Our learning is sequential, measurable, and goal specific.

How often do you clean the rooms and toys? All of our facilities (including toys) are cleaned multiple times a day. The bathrooms and the changing tables are disinfected continuously over the course of the day.

What is your policy regarding sick children? In order to keep our children and their families, and our staff, as healthy as possible, we require that any child with a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or contagious disease be kept at home.

What are your health policies? In NJ a complete health assessment form by the child's primary care provider is required. It is the parent's responsibility to maintain

current health and immunization records.

Do you have a playground, is there daily outside time?

We have a playground on the rear of our building. We have a small sized jungle gym, as well as sand, water play and children's garden in the spring and summer. The playground is fenced in for security. The play yard also is covered in mulch to avoid playground injuries. In addition to free play we conduct learning experiences outside on a regular basis. (Weather permitting.)

Do you have technology? We are proud to offer the ABC Mouse program in our classrooms. All children have their own account and learn at their own pace. Accounts may also be logged into from home so parents can see what their child is working on and let the learning continue at home!

What security measures are in place to protect my child? Your child's safety and your peace of mind are of the utmost concern. Our entire facility is locked from the outside and the play yard is fenced in. We have automatic smoke and fire detection alarms and all staff have criminal background checks, fingerprinting, and emergency preparedness training.

How is tuition paid? We are happy to offer our families an easy auto-pay service. This prevents late payments and late fees! Enrollment is simple to do and is FREE!

Who provides meals and snacks? Families provide all meals and snacks for their children. We do offer a daily lunch that may be purchased as well as snacks in our r café area.

Is potty trained a requirement? Your child DOES NOT have to be potty trained. Preschool admission is not based upon this skill. All children develop at their own pace. Staff members will help parents when it is time to toilet train and appositive plan will be implemented!



What is your admissions policy? Kidz Campus is a non-discriminatory program and admits all students and staff from all races, religious beliefs, ethnic backgrounds, and national origin. We are a non-religious school but we do celebrate all holidays and celebrations found in our school community. We strive to reach respect and understanding of all people.

What is Playcare? Playcare is drop in childcare and programs for our enrolled families. This is only available to children registered in our program. This option is available based upon classroom space and school activities.

Academic Programs

Our goal is to help each child develop a positive attitude toward school and learning by fostering self-confidence through educational success in a caring environment.

Our educational program is based upon the philosophies of Montessori, Piaget, & Best Practices BrainSMART. We use the Lovebug Learning Preschool Curriculum, a literature based, academic program. We also follow NAEYC's developmentally appropriate guidelines:

*The "whole child" approach: The primary goal of the educational programs is to help each child reach full potential in ALL areas of development.

*The "prepared environment": In order for self-directed learning to take place, the environment must be supportive for active learning. This enables the child to try new things and builds self-confidence.

*Classroom materials and structure: The materials are developmentally appropriate, organized, and accessible to teachers and children.

*The teacher: The teacher functions as a facilitator of learning, she is a role model, demonstrator, and observer. She has open communication and supportive relationships with families.

Every day in our classrooms we actively explore and discover in learning centers and in teacher led activities. We also offer program enhancements such as:

Our curriculum is a literature based program that has weekly themes and book selections. The curriculum is designed to assure that children acquire measurable learning goals across the year. Specific goals are targeted on a weekly and monthly basis. The curriculum focuses upon developmentally appropriate goals for preschool age children. These goals are broken down into specific, measurable, and sequential skills that are incorporated into the curriculum.

The curriculum is designed to introduce concepts over the course of a week and then to reinforce skills and concepts through:

- Repeated class instruction and review.
- Development and reinforcement of skills and knowledge throughout various learning centers.
- Group activities.
- Individual activities.
- Take home work.

In addition to the book themed curriculum there are also special fun days and holiday events every month. We also have a community service project every month.

Our developmentally appropriate curriculum in the preschool and prekindergarten classes is outlined below. The curriculum is designed to assure that children acquire measurable learning goals across the year. Specific goals are targeted on a weekly and monthly basis. The curriculum focuses upon developmentally appropriate goals for three year olds to five year olds. These goals are broken down into specific,



How Does Hourly Playcare Work?

While you are working, shopping or having lunch with friends your child will join our daily program of fun and learning. While you are away your children will be in a structured program with free play time, art, gym, music, and reading activities.

Playcare is not open to the general public, it is exclusively for our registered families.

- •Playcare is open specific times; call ahead and check the schedule.
- •You may add Playcare to your child's class schedule for an extended day.
- •1 hour minimum; billed in 30 minute increments
- •We give a 5 minute grace period when picking up your child.
- •Age 2 years and older, age availability may vary, check with Kidz Campus. *Children who stay after 11:30 need to bring or purchase lunch.*
