The General Fund receives gifts/offerings that are distributed for the operating and outreach expenses of the congregation. The annual budget is adopted by the congregation and managed by the Administrative Council.

Ten percent of all gifts to the General Fund are used for benevolence and outreach as reflected in the adopted budget.

Bequests to the General Fund help the congregation strengthen its basic ministries and maintain its ability to serve the faith needs of members as well as the community and the world.

If the bequest to the General Fund is a significant amount, the giver may wish to designate uses for the gift. An example might be debt reduction, capital improvements, enhancement of a particular ministry, etc.



Giftling Language

Upon my death, my Trustee/Personal Representative shall distribute \$_____ OR ___% of my estate to the General Fund of King of Glory Lutheran Church, located in Loveland, Colorado, or its successor in interest.

My distribution to the General Fund shall be designated for these purposes:

If King of Glory Lutheran Church no longer exists, and has no successor in interest or its successors in interest cannot be identified with reasonable certainty, this distribution will lapse, and the property subject to this distribution instead will be distributed under the other provisions of this trust/will.
