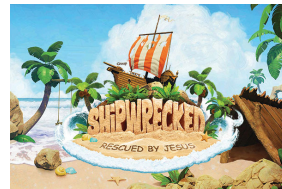


Plant a Garden! We will be planting the KOG plots next Saturday, June 2.
