Annexation/Landscaping: It is finished!

When the congregation added the Education and Fellowship wing of our building several years ago, previous councils set aside \$100,000 for future annexation costs. The annexation process was delayed for more years than originally anticipated, so the requirements changed and the eventual costs increased. With the landscaping along Wilson Avenue and 29th Street and the extension of the new sprinkler system and grass seeding to the area between the edge of the street-side landscaping and the building, the final project of our annexation has been completed.

The costs of this project exceeded the amount set aside for annexation by \$4,473.83.

The impact to our general reserves was partially offset by a memorial gift of \$1,000 and \$1,000 left in the Mission Investment Fund account to keep it open for future investments.

Thanks to all who have carefully stewarded our financial resources and donated so many volunteer hours to the completion of the entire annexation process.
