Church Together at the Border
 The last two weeks in July will include a large-scale reunification of parents & children separated under the Zero Tolerance policy. The objective is to reunify 1,500 children in the next 2 weeks.
Peace Lutheran Church in Las Cruces and Iglesia Luterana Cristo Rey in El Paso are partnering with Annunciation House to offer hospitality in their congregations.

The ELCA Rocky Mountain Synod is establishing a Border Emergency Fund to support the work of Cristo Rey and Peace as they host refugees and assist in the reunification of immigrant families. It costs \$100 to provide hospitality to a family staying at one of our RMS congregations, as they assist them getting to their sponsor.” **Our goal is to raise \$10,000 for immediate needs.**
