**Update from the Call Committee**

We continue our discernment journey to find the right person to fill the Faith Formation minister position here at King of Glory. The process has evolved and has been exciting, hopeful, challenging, frustrating and encouraging along the way. As of today, we do not have a candidate to present to the congregation, but we remain convinced God will lead us to that person meant to join our wonderful ministry team.

The pool of potential candidates has been limited throughout. Additional candidates have been presented as we have progressed through interviews. We reported to you in November that we have learned along the way that a Deacon/Deaconess may be a good idea in theory, but there are practical limits and very few candidates out there to consider.

Our experience and learning curve have led us to find that our search most likely may lead us to a “word and sacrament” candidate – an associate pastor. This could be very exciting for not only our faith formation ministry but our ministry in general. This person could add an additional layer of support in helping Pr Ruth Ann address many pastoral cares now in her sole plate of responsibilities

We can only make recommendations. The congregation makes the final decision. We ask you to remain open to the possibilities God may bring us, and ask you to pray for the process that will discern what God has for us.
