#### People of Faith - God's Story

Pr Ruth Ann and Pr Deb are excited to bring a summer preaching series to worship. Our theme is "People of Faith – God's Story." The objective is to return to Biblical stories we might have learned as children in Sunday

school. Looking at them again as adults, what do they mean? How do those stories connect with our daily lives? Who are the characters and how does God use them, even though they are imperfect people? We will spend seven weeks looking at Old Testament stories of Adam & Eve, Noah & Flood, Abraham & Sarah, Moses, David, Debra, Esther, and Jonah. Then in August we'll catch up on New Testament characters of Paul, Lydia, Anna & Simeon, and Peter.

#### Rocky Mountain Synod Assembly Report May 9-11, 2022 - Loveland, CO

"The Rhythm of the Saints" was the theme of the gathering of the ELCA Rocky Mountain Synod from Colorado, New Mexico, Texas, Utah and Wyoming. The 158 congregations in the Synod sent 309 voting delegates. This was the first opportunity to meet in person since the COVID 19 pandemic effected so many lives.

It was a wonderful time to meet and greet colleagues, new ministers and deacons, Synod Board and committee members, old and new friends and brothers and sisters in Christ. It was a time of celebration to proclaim God's grace, Jesus' unconditional love, and the gifts of the Spirit. It is our mission as Christians to share the message of love and hope to all. The Assembly also celebrated rostered minister anniversaries five years to seventy years. Pastor Ruth Ann celebrated her twenty years of ministry, accepting her certificate from Rev. James Gonia, Bishop of the Rocky Mountain Synod.

The assembly voted on one resolution in support of ELCA World Hunger and challenged congregations to increase support of local hunger ministries, increase awareness of hunger and poverty issues through educational resources developed by ELCA Word Hunger, and increase opportunities to financially support the work of ELCA World Hunger. The ELCA World Hunger is our ELCA church's ministry that responds to domestic and global hunger and poverty. KOG is a proud supporter and partner in this global effort. This resolution was submitted by Carol McDivitt, Chair of the Rocky Mountain Synod Hunger Network representing King of Glory Lutheran Church in Loveland.

The assembly voted on positions for Church Council, Synod Council, and several Synod and Congregational committees and boards. The voting members celebrated, expressed appreciation and offered support to each position elected. Congratulations to each of these faithful volunteers.

Bishop James Gonia invited us to gather to "equip the saints (all of us) for the work of service," not for maximum productivity, but for the sake of renewal and encouragement to continue the work of our ELCA ministry. The ELCA offers the resources and tools to examine "Church Becoming" efforts. The Plenary sessions offered the space for reflection and learning on the topics of:

 Church Becoming: The Church of Jesus is always a work in progress, look at the contrasts

- our life as a church that is still being shaped by the Holy Spirit.
- Normalizing the Unexpected: serve as slow wade into conversations and engagement that will assist members to recognize biases and truly embrace Jesus's command to "love one another as I have loved you."
- Courageous-Resilient-Faithful: Leading in today's world takes courage, resiliency and faithfulness. ELCA Excellence in Leadership Team offers tools and skills training to learn how to love with God's steadfast love.
- Vital Right-Shaped Ministry: How can our church's ministry "shape itself" for the future? ELCA offers tools for congregation and ministers to review their congregational life, set a course for the future, and strengthen ministers and those they serve for the journey ahead.
- Generosity and a Mindset of Abundance. Asks congregations to explore key abundance principals and opportunities to shift our culture from prosperity to generosity.

The RMS ELCA Synod Assembly ended with the installation of elected officials, the celebration of the sharing of faith and love for all God's children. It was an honor and pleasure to be given the opportunity to represent our church family.
