#### Letter from Pastor Deb

November 22, 2022

Dear King of Glory Lutheran Church,

After much prayer and discernment I am resigning my call from King of Glory Lutheran Church effective December 31, 2022. My last Sunday with you will be December 18, 2022.

It has been made clear to me over the past several months of budget cuts for 2022 and 2023 that the call I accepted in August of 2019 no longer exists. The mission and ministries of the church that include outreach, youth ministry and music have been and are being cut substantially. With budget cuts of \$150,000 for 2023 the mission and ministry of this congregation will be very different going forward.

It has been an honor and a blessing to be a part of your lives and faith journeys. Thank you for offering me the opportunity to serve with you in ministry.

Dear King of Glory,

It is with sadness that we received the resignation letter of Pastor Deb. Over the last four years she has accomplished much. In her ministries of Faith Formation, Pastor Deb helped solidify the youth ministries between ourselves, and our partner congregations, Trinity and Zion. Youth are eager to come to Girl Talk and Man Cave, Confirmation, Middle School and High School events and programs. Parents have had regular and timely communication. Volunteers have been recruited. She facilitated the meetings with our colleagues around these ministries. King of Glory's families and children had a constant supporter and teacher in Pastor Deb who drove weekly Sunday school lessons to them during the pandemic.

Overseeing our Outreach, she directed school supplies and diaper drives. Toys at Christmas for needy children and food for the hungry happened under her watch. She led worship and preached God's Word. Members were comforted by her presence and conversations. Pastor Deb rang bells and sang in the choir.
