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Frequently asked questions

1) What is the background and experience of the staff?

Lake Montessori Camp's staff are well trained and passionate leaders. Each of our staff members brings unique skills and attributes to the camp to ensure that your campers have a well-rounded summer experience. Our staff members are First Aid and CPR certified.

2) Is Lake Montessori Camp co-ed?

Yes.

3) What is the cost?

There are multiple session options to best fit your summer break needs. A full week session costs \$180.00.

4) Will all campers participate in the activities?

Each month will contain various cooking activities, crafts, and history lessons designed around the summer holidays. The children will get dirty, play and enjoy their summer while at Camp Montessori. We also have field trips planned throughout the summer. Some field trip examples are going to the library, Jungle Zone, bowling alley, the movies and so much more!

5) What are the dates and times of the camp?

Camp runs Monday through Friday from June 5th through July 28th. Drop off begins at 8:30am with camp activities beginning at 9:00am. Camp ends daily at 5:30pm. Snacks will be provided throughout the day, however, campers are responsible for his/her own lunch.

Any child picked up after 5:30pm will be subjected to an additional late fee of \$1.00 for each additional minute thereafter.

6) What do campers need to bring to camp?

1. Pillow/blanket for resting time
2. A rested body and mind
3. Lunch and water bottle with the camper's name clearly marked on ALL the items
4. Spare outfit and shoes
5. Comfortable shoes for running. NO flip-flops, crocs or other backless shoes
6. Comfortable and appropriate clothing that will not be offended by dirt and other messy activities
7. Sun gear: hat, sunglasses and sunscreen

- 7) What to expect as a camper and/or as the parent/guardian or a camper at Camp Montessori:
Children should expect to have lots of fun, make new friends, be challenged and get very dirty and wet during many different indoor and outdoor activities.

Release of Liability

I understand and agree that Lake Montessori Camp, of which my child is a participant, involves certain risks and regardless of the precautions taken by the organization, bodily injuries may occur. Activities take place both indoors and outdoors, where participants are subject to a variety of physical contact with others during participation in contact and non-contact activities. Specific risks and hazards of the activities include, but not limited to, the following: tripping, falling, slipping, sliding, bumps, bruises, cuts, abrasions, contusions, dislocations, sprains, broken bones, pulled muscles, eye injuries, drowning, fatigue, altercations and sunburn.

Parents and children may be able to lessen the likelihood of such injuries by adhering to the following rules and procedures:

- 1) Understand and follow the rules of Lake Montessori Camp
- 2) Follow directives of staff during camp activities
- 3) Report and hazardous situations to staff immediately

In signing this release, I am granting my child permission to participate in all camp activities. This release, indemnity, and assumption of risk statement will cover all events and occurrences associated with the activities, including my child's participation, observation, associated food and transportation. If I have any concerns about my child's health or ability to participate, I agree to discuss my concerns with my physician before allowing my child to participate.

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What to Bring

When preparing to send your child to camp each day, please keep the following policies and the daily checklist in mind:

- 1) Label all of your child's belongings (both first and last name). Lost items will be held for 1 (one) week. Unclaimed items will be donated to a local charity. Lake Montessori Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 2) Lake Montessori Camp is an outdoor program. It is recommended that you send your child dressed in outdoor play clothes that are easy to wash. Please, do not send clothing or items with your that you are not comfortable having them use in our outdoor environment. Expensive clothing, toys and electronic items are not appropriate for camp.
- 3) On certain days, the program may include a special event, activity or craft that will have additional requirements.
- 4) If your child has medication to bring to camp or any allergy that we must be aware of, please ensure that you have completed the medication/allergy portion of the camp registration packet. You may also call our office at (352) 787 – 5333.

Items to be carried to camp each day:

- 1) Bathing suits/water play clothing
- 2) Afternoon snack if your child is staying past 4:00pm
- 3) Pillow and blanket
- 4) Rain gear (poncho or slicker) (we will play in the rain without lightning)
- 5) **Spare** set of clothing including:
 - 1) Shirt
 - 2) Closed-toed shoes (no Crocs or flip-flops or other backless shoes)
 - 3) Shorts
 - 4) Underwear
 - 5) Socks
- 6) Sun protection (hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, etc)
- 7) Full thermos or water bottle
- 8) Towel
- 9) Water shoes

Please, do not send your child to camp with expensive or irreplaceable items such as a phone, electronics or toys of any kind. Lake Montessori Camp is not responsible for damaged, broken, lost or stolen items.
