ORDINANCE NO. 3214

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 OF THE LOVELAND MUNICIPAL CODE, THE SAME ESTABLISHING THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST REQUIRING THE IMMEDIATE PASSAGE AND ADOPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVELAND, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Title 12 of the Loveland Municipal Code is amended by adding thereto a new Chapter 12.60, as follows:

Chapter 12.60

ART IN PUBLIC PLACES

12.60.010 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to provide a means to fund the acquisition of works of art by the City, which shall become the City's collection, to provide a means to select works of art for the collection, to provide for the display of the collection and to provide for the maintenance and repair of the works of art in the collection.

12.60.020 Definitions. For the purpose of this chapter the following words or phrases shall be defined as set out below:

A. "Art in Public Places" means any visual work of art displayed for two weeks or more in an open City-owned area, on the exterior of any City-owned facility, inside any City-owned facility in areas designated as public areas, or on non-City property if the work of art is installed or financed, either wholly or in part, with City funds or grants procured by the City.

B. "Commission" means the Visual Arts Commission created by Section 2.60.260.

C. "Construction cost" means actual cost of any construction project with an estimated construction cost of \$50,000 or more, excluding, however, engineering and administrative costs, costs of fees and permits and indirect costs, such as interest during construction, advertising and legal fees.
