THE BIBLE

The Rocks Cry Out Luke 19:37-40
(Psalm 105:2; Psalm 30:8-12)

FAMILY DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- In the Bible story, what were the disciples doing as Jesus was coming down the road? *Praising Him and shouting out loud.*
- What did Jesus say would happen if the disciples kept quiet? *The rocks would cry out.*
- Do you think you're more like the Pharisees or the disciples, and why?
- How can you worship God when you're not at church?
- What is your favorite worship song to sing to God?
- What is one reason you can praise God today?
- Look up and read Psalm 30:8-12. What do you think the writer of this Psalm was feeling when he wrote this song?
- When is it easy for you to sing God's praises? When is it hard?
- Is there anything keeping you from praising God? What are you going to do about it?

FAMILY ACTIVITIES

Make a list of your family's favorite worship songs (or any song they're all familiar with). One parent should start to sing part of the song, then stop them in the middle and prompt the kids to finish the line. **Say and ask this...**



- One of the ways we can worship God is through singing. People in the Bible sang songs to God a lot. They sang when something good happened, when something bad happened, when they made a commitment to God, and when they remembered the good things He had done for them.
- What is one reason you can sing to God today?
