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Year at a Glance

- **22,356** visits conducted with individuals seeking assistance
- **7,179** requests from **4,495** individuals for **64,630** clothing & personal care items
- **80,827** hot, nutritious meals served in the Community Cafe
- **996,403** pounds of groceries distributed via **19,138** household visits, equating to **41,188** individuals, from the Community Market
- **349** households given utility shut-off prevention
- **349** rent vouchers provided to prevent homelessness
- **9** families given emergency shelter
- **97** households received intensive self-sufficiency case management services
- **302** homeless individuals provided food, clothing, transportation to shelter, laundry vouchers, medical screenings, voice mail, job & housing referrals
- **53** children received day care and school readiness programs at Aspen Center for Child Development
- **2,541** individuals participated in classes, services, and programs provided in Family Resource Center activities

Community Support:

- More than **1,600** volunteers provided **40,851** hours of work as receptionists, intake workers, food pantry clerks, computer consultants, data entry assistants, clothing bank helpers, lunch program assistants, childcare providers, board and committee members, maintenance workers, cleaners, fundraisers, and ambassadors. This equates to more than **\$1,008,000** worth of time.
- Over **1,500** donors provided financial support and more than **1,700** donors gave in-kind gifts.
