

Visit and Immunization Schedule

The Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) developmental screening is on our website and is an electronic format that can be sent directly to us. Please fill this out before your child's well check visits (from ages 2 months – 5 years). The Adolescent Medicine Questionnaire (AMQ), Depression Screening (PHQ-9), and MCHAT (Modified Checklist for Autism in Toddlers) are available in the Forms section of our website.

Immunizations and Procedures

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| Birth | Hep B #1 at the hospital |
| 3-7 Days of life visit | First visit for your newborn at PANC. |
| 2-4 Week Well Care | Hep B #1 if not given at the hospital |
| 2 Month Well Care | Pentacel (DTAP #1, IPOL #1, HIB #1), Hep B #2, Prevnar #1, Rotateq #1, ASQ |
| 4 Month Well Care | Pentacel (DTAP #2, IPOL #2, HIB #2), Prevnar #2, Rotateq #2, ASQ |
| 6 Month Well Care | Pentacel (DTAP #3, IPOL #3, HIB #3), Rotateq #3, Prevnar #3, Hep B #3, ASQ |
| 9 Month Well Care | ASQ |
| 12 Month Well Care | Hgb (Hemoglobin- anemia check via finger stick), Varivax #1, Hep A #1, MMR #1, Prevnar #4, HIB #4, ASQ |
| 15 Month Well Care | ASQ |
| 18 Month Well Care | DTAP #4, Hep A #2, ASQ, MCHAT |
| 2 Year Well Care | MCHAT, ASQ |
| 2 ½ Year Well Care | ASQ |

After 2 1/2 years of age, your child will require a well care visit annually, as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics. Child care forms, school forms, camp forms and sports forms all require annual well care visits. Please schedule your well care appointments as far in advance as possible, as these slots fill up quickly.

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| 3 Year Well Care | ASQ |
| 4 Year Well Care | Kinrix (DTAP #5, IPOL #4), Proquad (MMR #2, Varivax #2), ASQ |
| 5 Year Well Care | Kinrix (DTAP #5, IPOL #4), Proquad (MMR #2, Varivax #2) if not done at 4yr WCC, ASQ |
| 6 Year and Older Well Care | None, unless behind on vaccines |

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| 9-11 Year Well Care | Lipid screening (once during this age range) |
| 11 Year Well Care | Adacel (Tdap), Menactra #1, Gardasil (HPV series), Hep A (if not complete) |
| 12 Years and Older Well Care | AMQ, PHQ-9 (Depr Screening) |
| 16 Years Well Care | Menactra #2, Update shots if needed. AMQ, PHQ-9 |
| 17-21 Years and Older Well Care | Lipid screening (once during this age range). Update shots if needed. AMQ, PHQ-9, Meningococcal Group B vaccine pre college |

- Varivax may be given at any time after 1 year of age unless your child has already had the chicken pox disease.
- In our experience, we have found that preparing children for shots may be useful; however, don't do this too far in advance as it may cause excessive worry. We recommend that you do not administer Tylenol or Advil prior to your child's vaccines. It may be administered, only if necessary, following the vaccines. Please do not promise your child that they will not be receiving vaccinations. The immunization schedule is constantly changing and we want your child to be prepared to receive them if necessary.
