What did PLC do today?

_____ Technician

_____ Today I applied the Spring Pre-emerge Weed Control application. This treatment provides:

- Preventive Control of crabgrass and other spring and summer annual weeds before they germinate
- Post-emergent Control of winter weeds that may already be in the lawn. Visible changes usually seen in 5-7 days, may take 21+ days for weeds to die.

_____ Today I also applied fertilizer to Fescue areas ONLY

What to do Next

-Keep pets and people off of sprayed areas until dry.

-Wait until after the next rainfall before raking or doing winter clean-up.

-New lawns or lawns with significant weed growth:

Mowing in 7-10 days will speed weed control and help appearance. Bagging clippings is recommended.

-Mulching leaves and clippings is acceptable at any time.

-Scalping should be done in late winter (see next page)

Touchup Policy

Weed control applications are warranted for 30 days after service. Weed control touchups between applications are provided (if needed) at no charge for clients who have selected the **PLC Preferred Service** plan (three weed control applications and two or more fertilizations.) For clients who have selected reduced service plans (less than five applications), any touchups requested after the 30 day window will be available, but may be as a charged application.

Invoicing

As a reminder, **invoices are due and payable upon receipt, which is always at the time of service or after the application is complete.** Invoices are considered Past Due 15 days from the date of the service. All invoices not paid by the 35th day after service will receive a reminder/statement that has a \$5 statement charge added to the invoice. PLC also suspends service for clients with outstanding invoices over 35 days old until the balances are paid. If necessary, we send another reminder/statement on the 60th and 90th days with an additional \$5 statement charge each time. After the 90th day, PLC cancels service and determines what further collections action needs to be taken regarding the balance.

Be on the lookout: Spring Combo

For clients receiving both the **Spring Fertilization** and **Spring Weed Control** applications, PLC will again be using a slow release, liquid fertilizer in 2017.

So even though your technician may not be spreading a granular fertilizer, you will still get the same great results.

Zoysia Disease Treatment

Many zoysia lawns have shown an increase in large patch fungal infection as well as zoysia mite damage. Curative and Preventive treatments are available to help restore the beauty of your lawn. Ask your technician or contact us for treatment information and options.

A note about Scalping:

Scalping bermuda and zoysia lawns is a recommended practice in the late winter. Scalping, mowing the lawn on the lowest possible setting, removes last year's remaining growth, reducing thatch and allowing good green-up. While scalping is very beneficial to your lawn, it can also cause a lot of damage if done improperly.

4 things to remember about scalping:

1. Fescue lawns should **never** be scalped unless renovation is scheduled. Keep fescue mowed at 3"+ all year long.
2. Bermuda and zoysia lawns should be scalped in late February to mid March, as they begin to green-up around the edges.
3. Scalping too early reduces the natural insulation grass gives itself. Scalping too late risks damaging early growth.
4. Gradually raise mowing heights during the season until bermuda and zoysia are being maintained at 2 - 3" through the season
