What did PLC do today?

Today I did the following application:

_____ Fall and Winter Pre-emerge and Weed Control (SP3): This application prevents germination of winter annual weeds and controls any existing broadleaf weeds such as dandelions, henbit, or wild onions.

What to do Next

- Please keep pets and children off sprayed areas until it has dried thoroughly, approximately 1 hour.
- Wait up to 24-48 hours and (if it has not rained) water **15-30 min** in each area. Watering moves the pre-emerge into the soil.
- Mow as needed. If it hasn't rained, **BE SURE** you water before you mow! If watering is not possible, please **MULCH** clippings.

A Note About Watering

It will be to your lawn's advantage to water as needed until killing frost. Give special attention to any damaged areas of Bermuda and Zoysia lawns. Fescue lawns may be watered once per week through the winter if we do not receive rain and the soil becomes dry. Typical lawns need approximately 1 inch of rainfall (or equivalent) per week year round in order to promote good growth. Please see our Face Book page or visit www.personallawn care.com for information, timely tips and hints. Proper watering is especially important for newly sodded or seeded lawns.

A Note About Lime

PLC recommends that each of our clients lime their lawns **every other year**. Lime reduces acids in the soil, improves weed control effectiveness and helps optimize the effects of the fertilization. A **soil analysis** can be performed in order to determine the exact levels of acidity and nutrients present in your soil. Many of our clients are already on our lime rotation.

Tips About Mowing

- As we head into the fall season, please leave your lawn mowed *at the same height as for summer*. Mowing too closely for the winter causes the lawn to lose the natural insulation effect of the turf.
- Scalping** of Bermuda and Zoysia lawns should be done in early spring (about the time the edges begin greening up).
- Fescue should always be mowed at 3 inches or higher unless close mowing is needed for seeding or renovation.
