Insect / Disease Control (ID3)

What did PLC do today?

Today, I treated your lawn with our ID3 application—three different products designed to prevent or control insects and disease in your lawn.

___ 1 - **Fungicide**: designed to **prevent** or treat Zoysia patch and other fungi that are affecting lawns in our area. Since fungicides are not always a “one-n-done” application, when treating significant outbreaks or if conditions favorable to fungal infection persist, additional applications may be required. Please let us know if symptoms persist or worsen.

___ 2 - **Surface Insecticide**: for control of surface insects and mites. These insects may simply be a nuisance or they may cause significant damage to your lawn, but they can be managed. As with the fungicide, additional applications may be necessary for season-long control.

___ 3 - **Soil Insecticide**: a systemic insecticide designed to control grubs (beetle larvae) and other soil insects that feed on the turf. Grubs cause damage to your lawn by eating the roots of the grass, eventually weakening or killing it. If moles are an issue in your lawn, treating for grubs may be one step in mole control, but it will not eliminate them completely. For more information on mole control check out our blog:

What to do Next

- Wait at least 24hr and (if it hasn't rained) water **20-30 min** in each area. Watering moves the fungicide into the soil where it can be most effective.
- Before you mow, make sure the lawn has been watered thoroughly or it has rained. **If you must mow before the lawn is watered, mulch the clippings.**

Special Note on Watering

As we approach fall and the temperatures start to cool down, it is very important that you continue to water your lawn about 1 inch of rainfall or equivalent per week until the first frost. Adjust irrigation times to start after 7 am if possible and don't water in the evenings. Prolonged times with wet grass increases Zoysia disease development.
