_____ 1 – **Surface Insecticide:** For control of surface insects and mites. Whether a nuisance or causing significant damage to your lawn, these insects can be managed. Additional applications may be necessary for season-long control.

_____ 2 – **Soil Insecticide:** Designed to control soil insects that feed on turf. These pests cause damage to lawns by eating the roots, stems, or leaves of the grass, eventually weakening or killing it. If moles are an issue in your lawn, treating for grubs may be one step in mole control, but it will not eliminate them completely. What To Do Next

- Keep pets and people off of sprayed areas until dry – usually about 1 hour.
- Wait 24-72 hours and water 20-30 minutes in each area, if it does not rain. Watering moves the remaining insecticides into the soil where they are most effective.
- The first time you mow after the insecticide application, mulch the clippings – DO NOT BAG.
