Watering, Lime & Mowing

Special tips on:

Watering: It will be to your lawn's advantage to water as needed until killing frost. Give special attention to any damaged areas of Bermuda and Zoysia lawns. Fescue lawns may be watered once per week through the winter if we do not receive rain and the soil becomes dry. Typical lawns need approximately 1 inch of rainfall (or equivalent) per week year-round in order to promote good growth. Please see our Facebook page or visit PersonalLawnCare.com for information, timely tips, and hints. Proper watering is especially important for newly sodded or seeded lawns.

Lime: We recommend that each of our clients lime their lawns every other year. Lime reduces acids in the soil, improves weed control effectiveness and helps optimize the effects of fertilization. A Soil Analysis can be performed in order to determine the exact levels of acidity and nutrients present in your soil. Many of our clients are already on our lime rotation. Mowing: Mow your lawn to the same height during the fall season as you used for summer. Mowing too closely for the winter causes the lawn to lose the natural insulation effect of the turf. Scalping of Bermuda and Zoysia lawns should be done in the early spring (about the time the edges begin greening up). Fescue should always be mowed at 3 inches or higher unless close mowing is needed for seeding or renovation.
