

INSTRUCTIONS TO PREPARE FOR BED BUG TREATMENT
PREDATOR PEST CONTROL INC.

On _____ at _____ AM/PM, a **Predator Pest Control Service Professional** will stop by to treat for bedbugs.

This particular service requires a certain amount of preparation prior to the technician's arrival to make sure your home or apartment is properly serviced. Simply follow the steps listed below to help ensure the best results from the bed bug service.

() Empty all closets, dresser and any drawers of all clothing and other items. Any bedding or sheets from the infested room should be placed in plastic bags. Any window treatments in infested areas should be included (curtains/sheers). All items should be placed in a clothing dryer on HIGH HEAT, unless heat will damage item. Check tag for cleaning instructions. Bed Bugs die when exposed to 120 degrees fahrenheit for over an hour. We suggest that you put all clothes into the washing machine and run them for **2 cycles** in the dryer.

() Remove all items from under the bed so we may have access to the bed frame for treatment. If your mattress and or box spring is located on the floor it must be placed inside of a certified mattress encasement and placed on a bed frame and not back on the floor.

() All toys and other belongings in infested room must be removed from closet, inspected and left for technician to treat.

() Bed Bugs die when exposed to 120 degrees fahrenheit for over an hour. We suggest that you put all materials that can be safely placed into the dryer for **2 cycles**.

() No items from the infested room, other than the belongings that can be washed and or placed in the dryer should be removed from the infested room. This prevents the spread of bed bugs throughout your house.

() Remove all pictures, posters and drawers from the dressers. These should be emptied so we may treat the cracks and crevices of the drawers.

() All the large furniture in the room must be removed from the wall area. We will need at least 18 inches to treat behind the furniture

() Ceilings with removable tiles must have several tiles removed so we may treat inner ceiling with an insecticide labeled to do so.

() Vacuum the entire room that was infested making sure you vacuum under the bed, all baseboards under furniture, rugs and inside any cracks or crevices. Be sure **not** to remove the vacuum bag outside of the infested room. As soon as you are done vacuuming remove the vacuum bag and place it in a **zip sealed bag** and then **immediately** out of the house into a garbage can on the exterior.

() After you vacuum place the vacuum bag in a plastic garbage bag and seal it.

() People and pets may not be in the room or house when treatment is being performed. We recommend that no one or animal re-enters the dwelling for **four hours** after the treatment then air out the house for two hours then return.

() Pets of any type including fish must be removed from unit to be treated.

Please be advised that some bed bug infestations may be particularly difficult to eradicate. If in the event it is deemed necessary to retreat an area it must be done **no** sooner than 12 days from the last treatment. Everybody reacts differently to bed bug bites, some people show signs of bites immediately after being bit while others show no signs at all. It has been documented that some people can show effects of a bed bug bite for up to 18 days from

actually being bit. Please be aware that showing signs of a bed bug bite does not constitute a current active infestation.

Failure to follow any of the above preparation requirements may result in an incomplete treatment and re-infestation. Predator Pest Control reserves the right to charge an additional fee if any of the preparation procedures listed above were not followed appropriately and the customer requests an additional service for the treatment of bed bugs. Please be advised that a Bed Bug infestation may be caused by an individual repeatedly bringing in infested clothes or bed bugs from another source (work, school, public transportation, another house), if this is the case it is the customer's responsibility to ensure all measures that are out of control of our technician are resolved immediately. Predator Pest Control makes no guarantees as to the complete eradication of future bed bug infestations to the property. We issue a 30 day warrantee from the initial treatment on all of or bed bug services. If at any time after 10 days of a bed bug treatment being performed by Predator Pest Control, the customer can show a representative a sample of a live bug in the area that was previously treated. We will re-treat the area at no additional charge (all preparation work must be performed by the customer prior to re-treatment).

NOTE: There must be adequate ventilation and space to work at the time of treatment for our licensed applicators.
