

### POINTS TO PONDER



With school starting, now is the time to refresh ourselves on the driving precautions to observe to keep our school children safe.

\*When backing out of a driveway or leaving a garage, watch out for children walking or bicycling to school.

\*When driving in neighborhoods with school zones, watch out for young people who may be thinking about getting to school but may not be thinking of getting there safely.

Watch for children walking in the street, \*Slow down. especially if there are no sidewalks.

\*Be alert. Children arriving late for the bus may dart into the street without looking for traffic.

\*Learn and obey the school bus laws. Learn the "flashing signal light system" that school bus drivers use to alert motorists of pending actions.
