# Winter Road Safety

As winter months quickly approach, temperatures start to drop and days get shorter. Bitter winter conditions could put you or your family in danger while on the road, especially if your car breaks down or an accident occurs. To stay safe during winter roadside emergencies, build a car safety kit with the following:

- Flashlight
- Blanket, hats, gloves, coats
- Ice scraper
- Bag of kitty litter or sand to create tire traction or melt snow
- Plenty of water
- Non-perishable, high energy foods like nuts and dried fruits
- Matches
