The iVantage Health Analytics' Hospital Strength INDEX is the tool used by The Chartis Center for Rural Health to measure where Critical Access Hospitals rank amongst each other in the nation. The INDEX's assessment uses Inpatient Share Ranking, Outpatient Share Ranking, Cost, Charge, Quality, Outcomes, Patient Perspective and Financial Stability to evaluate each hospital.

COMME Trauma Designation

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) has designated Rawlins County Health Center as a Level IV Trauma Center. The primary role of a Level IV Trauma Center is to stabilize seriously injured patients and transfer them to a higher-level center, if necessary.

Points to Ponder...

Harmful Substances in the Home

Potentially harmful substances used in homes usually have one or more of these characteristics:

- Corrosive
 — they eat or wear away at materials
- Flammable- easily ignited
- Reactive—can cause an explosion or produce deadly vapors
- Toxic-poisonous to humans and animals

Some examples of hazardous wastes found around the home include antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, chemical strippers, chlorine bleach, contact cement, drain cleaners, insecticides, lawn chemicals, nail polish remover, spot removers, motor oil and toilet and oven cleaners.

Follow these common household chemical safety tips to avoid harm or injury:

- Never combine two chemicals. For example, chlorine bleach and ammonia combined form a highly toxic gas, which can cause sever respiratory injury or death.
- Do not store hazardous chemicals near food.
- Store chemicals out of reach of children and pets.
- Never take chemicals or cleaners out of their original containers.
- Properly dispose household and chemical products that are leaking, expired or look bad. If you don't know how to dispose of them, contact your local waste management facility.
