## EXTERIOR RAISED PANELS

The raised panel shutter is very popular and adds depth and dimension to the exterior of the building. They offer a handsome, classic look for Georgian, Eclectic and Cottage style homes. They are constructed with a top rail, bottom rail and two side stiles. All stiles will be 2" x 1-1/8". The inside raised panel is beveled on all four sides which is inserted into a routed channel in the stiles and rails. A divider rail can also be inserted to create multiple raised panels within the shutter. The raised panels for the narrow shutters are made from the same cedar as the stiles and rails, however wider panels are usually made from MDF which weathers well, but these can only be painted, not stained.

Step # 1: Measure the width, then the height you need

Step # 2: Do you want a divider rail? All divider rails will be centered in the panel. (Special order available upon request.) When you call to order, remember to tell us if the shutters will be painted or stained.

<b>MATERIAL</b>	Incese Cedar
<b>FINISH</b>	Unfinished, ready to paint or stain
<b>ASSEMBLY</b>	Joints glued and doweled on 1" centers
<b>STILES</b>	1 1/8" x 2"
<b>TOP RAIL</b>	Varies
<b>BOTTOM RAIL</b>	1 1/8" x 4 3/8"

Widths: 12"-24" on the inch.  
Heights: 18"-96" on the inch.

Raised Panel Shutters can be made in combination with fixed Louvers of 1-1/4", 1-3/4" or 2-1/4".

Raised Panel made from exterior MDF, center rail is optional on style B.
