PERFORMANCE PROGRAM GENERAL INFORMATION

Performance Level tuition fees include weekly dance training, potential ribbon testing, special events, parent watching weeks, and multiple performances in our year end recital showcases . ALL Performance Level classes at Star Bound Dance Company have the cost of the recital costume, worn at the end of the season, built into the monthly cost of the class. Equipment for weekly classes is **NOT** included in the monthly tuition. This includes, but is not limited to, the weekly dance attire, dance shoes, tights, socks, pom poms or batons. Some items are purchased through the studio but most commonly, shoes and tights, can be picked up at East Side Sports in Airdrie. Students must wear weekly attire to regular season classes each week.

All Performance Level classes at SBDC are not viewed by parents weekly. We do host viewing weeks for these classes in October, December, February, and April of each season. The dates for these viewing weeks can be found on our website at www.stardancecompany.com under the calendar tab.

The calendar on our website is updated weekly to include any class scheduling changes, upcoming closures, special events, studio holidays, or specific dates pertaining to the studio. It is a great tool for parents to stay informed and can be found at www.stardancecompany.com. We also encourage registered parents to follow us on Facebook at “Star Bound Dance Company” and “Kendra Sbdc” as well as on Instagram at sbdc_airdrie_ab. Our social media is updated on a regular basis when we are in season and not only helps keep parents up to date but shows the ongoing of students in our programs.

Performance Level classes will run at SBDC with a minimum class count of 6 students and a maximum class count of 12 students. Registration for our 2022-2023 full season closes on September 30th, 2022. All classes will run for the month of September until registration closes at which point adjustments will be made based on registration. Should a class be terminated come October, no charges will be made from the month of October forward.

At the time of registration, Star Bound Dance Company requires the registration fee and first month’s tuition (both non refundable, non transferrable) in order to hold a dancers spot. Payments can then be made monthly **ONLY** via credit card (Visa/MasterCard) withdrawal.

Star Bound Dance Company guarantees 33 classes in a September-June season. Our tuition is seasonal broken into monthly payment installments. We **do not** accept withdrawals from our Performance Program **after March 31st, 2023** (balance of tuition (Apr-June) will be charged out to the CC on file). The only exception is a medical emergency with an official note from a physician. Students withdrawing from the Performance Program at any time in the season are responsible for a onetime payout of the recital costume which will then be held for pick up until June 30th, 2023.

The SBDC Office is operated by Mrs. Deborah Bliss. She is in charge of the studio financials, organization, registration, and parent relations. She is generally in office during the season Monday-Wednesday from 4:30-8:30pm, however, this does fluctuate. ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE PROGRAMS

PRESCHOOL DANCE (Ages 3-4)

Preschool Dance Classes are combination classes meaning students train more than one dance discipline during their class time. Students must be age 3 by September 17th in order to participate in this class. Students explore basic dance training, rhythm, movement, singing, and imagination while learning basic classroom etiquette, socialization, and the joy of dance. Parents do not attend weekly class with their dancer; however, we host a watching week for parents in October, December, February, and April. These students perform a rehearsed routine on stage in our Year End Recital Showcase.

KINDER BALLET (Ages 5-7)

Kinder Ballet is an introduction class to Ballet technique and Ballet training. We use this program as a feeder into our competitive Ballet program. Students learn the Primary/Grade 1 syllabus from the Royal Academy of Dance Program and are eligible for ribbon testing at the end of the season to move to our competitive program. This program focuses on dance technique while still evoking imagination, creative movement, whimsy and fun! These students perform a rehearsed routine on stage in our Year End Recital Showcase

KINDER JAZZ (Ages 5-7)

Kinder Jazz is an introduction class to Jazz technique and Jazz training. This class is perfect for an energetic dancer who can't sit still. These students learn Jazz using the ADAPT method and focus on basic technique and performance abilities. Rhythm, counting, and musicality are a main focus in this program. These students perform a rehearsed routine on stage in our Year End Recital Showcase.

KINDER/LEVEL 2 ACRO (Ages 5-7) (Ages 8-11)

Performance Level Acro classes are taught using the Acrobatic Arts syllabus and are introductory classes to acrobatic and dance training. Students learn basic and beginner tumbling, flexibility, strength, and balancing while also getting an introduction to Jazz training. Students in this program are eligible for ribbon testing at the end of the season to move into our official Acrobatic Arts program. This class is perfect for dancers who have a ton of energy, are bouncing off the walls, and love high energy music. These students perform a rehearsed routine on stage in our Year End Recital Showcase.

KINDER/JUNIOR POM CHEERLEADING (Ages 5-7) (Ages 8-11)

Pom Cheerleading combines Acro training with basic Jazz dance movement and Pom syllabus. These students are often called on for performance opportunities in our community. Students work on beginner skills and performance projection while dancing to upbeat music and working on flexibility, isolated movement, and basic tumbling. This class is perfect for all the sassy kids out there with high energy. Pom poms for these classes must be purchased through the studio in September. Students use studio provided pom poms until theirs arrive. These students perform a rehearsed routine on stage in our Year End Recital Showcase.

PERFORMANCE BATON TWIRLING (Ages 6-10)

Baton Twirling is getting back to our roots at SBDC and a program we are so excited to start offering. Students will learn basic baton twirling and synchronization skills alongside Jazz and Acro dance. Students in this program are often called on for performance opportunities in our community and will learn and perform a rehearsed routine in our Year End Recital Showcase. Our Baton Twirling Program is not affiliated with the CBTF although taught by Certified and World Level Champions. Our goal with this program is to create a safe, non competitive and joyful baton twirling experience geared towards performance. Batons can be purchased in Airdrie at East Side Sports.

KINDER/JUNIOR HIP HOP (Ages 5-7) (Ages 8-11)

Hip Hop is a great class for dancers that have a lot of energy and focus, love music, and can't stop moving. This class goes over an introduction to Street Jazz, basic Hip Hop isolation skills, Pop and Lock, and Breakdancing. Students engage with their teachers in a more relaxed environment and bust a move to top of the pops music. These students perform a rehearsed routine on stage in our Year End Recital Showcase.
