The Rock has partnered with The Weld County Food Bank to provide food items to our clients, make and serve hot meals, teach food safety and meal planning.

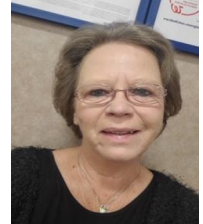
The Rock partners with Room 4 Hope on a annual coat drive for individuals at ICCS. Special thanks to everyone who worked to make the coat drive a success again this year!
