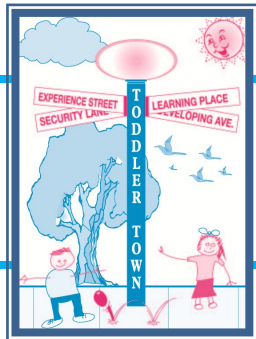

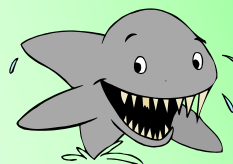
## PARENTS
